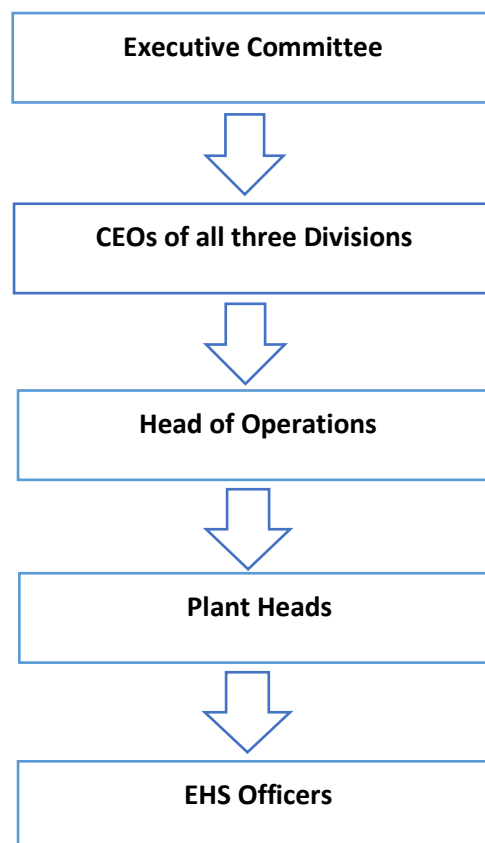
In furtherance of its objectives, the Company is committed to:

3. Continually improve the environmental performance of organisational processes and products and set objective-targets to reduce environmental impacts.
4. Minimise consumption of natural resources through the reduction, reuse or recycling of materials, as much as possible, minimise waste generation and practice effective waste management and abate pollution.
5. Strive to minimise environmental impacts generated from the end-of-life of the products, such as hazardous and non-hazardous waste generated.
6. Encourage efficient use of energy, water and utilities.
7. Strive to effectively manage the environmental impacts from use of Company’s products.
